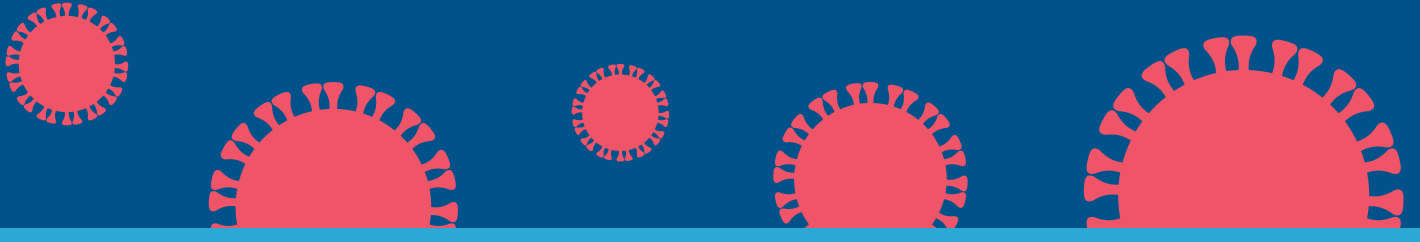


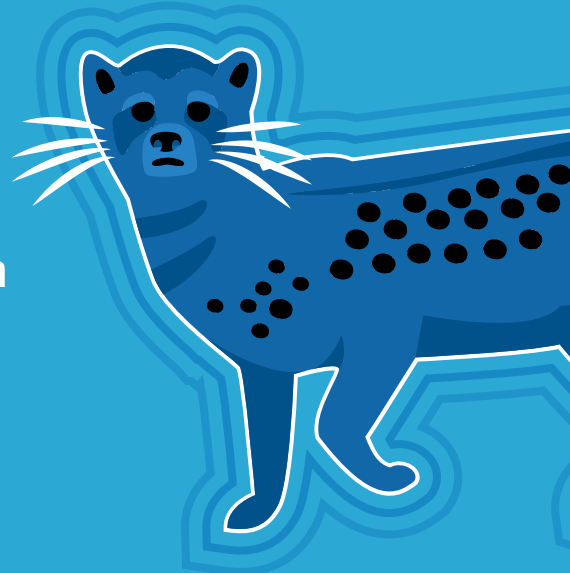
# Coronaviruses

Coronaviruses are a broad family of viruses, only 7 are known to infect people



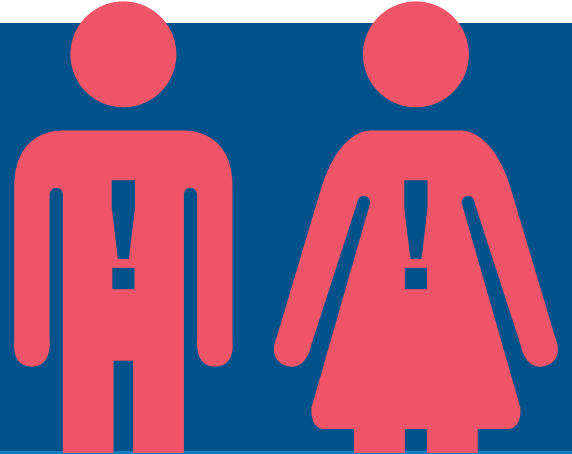
Coronaviruses have been passed to humans from animals

- SARS jumped from the civet cat into humans
- MERS regularly makes the jump from the dromedary camel



Coronaviruses can cause symptoms ranging from a mild cold all the way through to death

2019-nCoV, as it's been labelled, is understood to be a new strain of coronavirus that has not previously been identified in humans

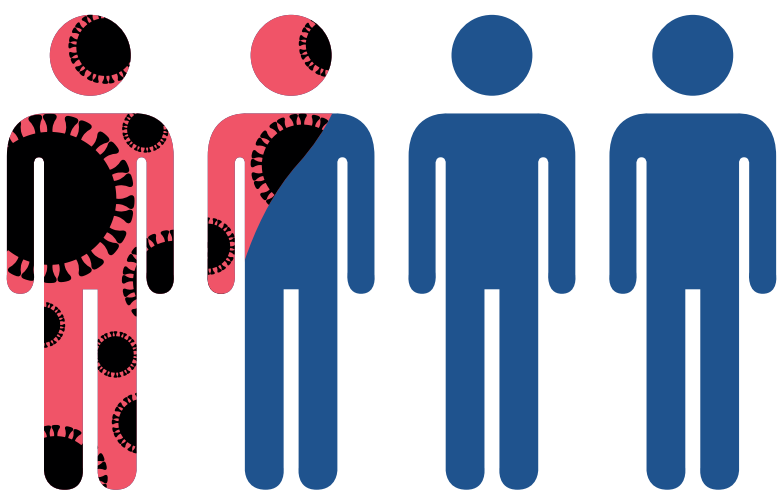
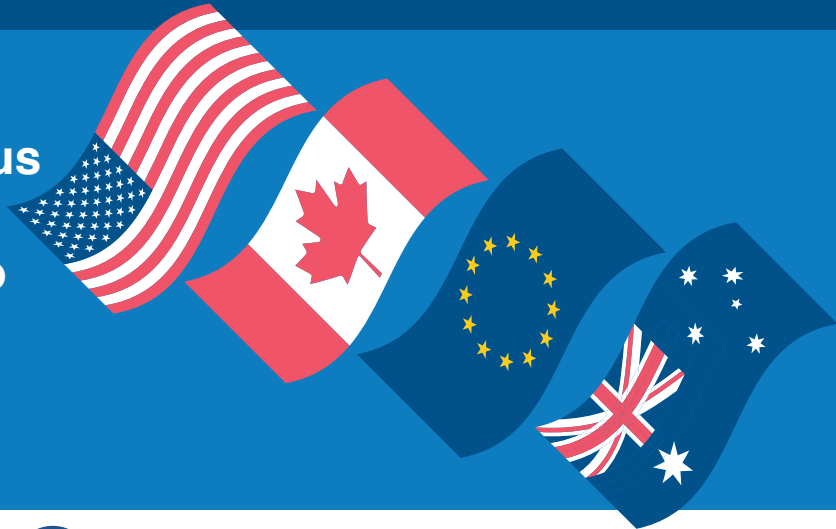


7th Jan - first case confirmed in Wuhan China

Within 3 weeks, over 4500 cases had been confirmed, and over 120 people killed
